The Joint School of Nanoscience and Nanotechnology, a joint academic program between **UNC-Greensboro** and **N.C. A&T State University**, has been named a finalist for the inaugural Prziembel Prize by InnoVenture Southeast.

The prize recognizes the best practices in open innovation and collaborations among diverse institutions across the Southeast.

The joint school was chosen as one of three finalists from 21 applications. Other finalists are the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Mine-Resistant Ambush-Protected vehicle program, in North Charleston, S.C., and the Carolinas Nuclear Cluster collaboration.

The winner will be named in May at the InnoVenture Southeast 2011 conference in Greenville, S.C.
